SERIES OVERVIEW

BIG IDEA

"Two against Ten" - While the other ten men who explored the Promised Land gave a negative report, Joshua and Caleb were resolute that with God they can face whatever stands before them. By faith, we learn to trust His promises when the plan doesn't always make sense.

- How can we learn to recognize and overcome negative thought patterns that might be limiting our perspective and potential in our own spiritual lives?

 How can we be better at shutting out the loud voices that are discouraging us or attempting to drown out the voice of God in our lives? How can we support each other?
