## SERIES OVERVIEW

- What are some tangible ways we can honor and celebrate God's faithfulness and provision in our lives, both individually and as a community?
- How can we pass on our faith and the stories of God's goodness to the next generation, as Joshua instructed the Israelites to do in Joshua 4:2-3?
