- Have you ever experienced a situation where you were forced to rely solely on God's power rather than your own abilities? What did you learn from that experience?
- Reflect on a time when you witnessed a seemingly impossible situation turn into a miracle. How
  did that impact your faith journey?
- How can we, as a group, encourage each other to trust in God's power when facing challenges or uncertainties?

#### **READ**

• GENESIS 17:1-6, 18:11-14, 21:6-7

#### **DISCUSS**

- How does the story of Abraham and Sarai in Genesis 17:1-6 encourage us to trust in God's power to fulfill His promises?
- Reflect on Sarah's initial disbelief in Genesis 18:11-14. How can we relate to her doubts, and what can we learn from God's response?
- Consider the joy expressed in Genesis 21:6-7 when Sarah bore a son. How can we apply this joy and gratitude to our own lives?
